Title: Snow Removal / Lawn Maintenance Technician
Reports To: Lawn Maintenance Supervisor
Status: Seasonal, Full Time, Non-Exempt

Job Purpose: Tree Trust's Landscape Services division offers professional tree care and landscaping services at market rates. What makes Landscape Services unique is the net profits support Tree Trust's non-profit work, including employment-readiness training to youth and young adults and community forestry initiatives. In this job, you will assist the Lawn Maintenance Supervisor in daily operations including commercial and residential property maintenance, snow removal, quality control, and safety. Employment is seasonal with the possibility to move to year-round employment after 90 days. Involvement in snow removal is a condition of year-round employment.

What you'll be doing:

1. Perform snow removal during winter months by utilizing a plow, snow blower and snow shovel on commercial and residential properties.
2. Daily preparation of trucks, equipment, and inventory: Daily preparation of trucks, equipment, and inventory: reporting on time to review schedule, check all equipment, perform routine maintenance on equipment, load and unload all tools and equipment.
3. Follow instruction from supervisor to accurately perform and manage landscape and maintenance tasks on client's property including all aspects of lawn maintenance: follow proper use of safety equipment and personal protective equipment, work as part of a team.
4. Perform daily duties: Accurately record hours worked, complete all reports, review and prepare for next day's jobs, load/unload/wash/repair equipment as necessary.
5. Strictly adhere to Tree Trust's safety policies and procedures.
6. Other duties as assigned.
