## Tree Trust-Landscape Services Job Postings

**Title:** Tree Care-Specialist

**Reports to:** Tree Care Supervisor

**Status:** Regular, Full Time, Non-Exempt

### Job Description:

This position is responsible for assisting the Tree Care Supervisor in daily operations including commercial and residential property tree care maintenance, quality control, and safety. Involvement in snow removal operations is a condition of year round employment.

### Essential Functions:

1. Daily preparation of trucks, equipment, and inventory.
  - Report on time to prepare and review the work schedule with the Tree Care Supervisor.
  - Load all tools, gasoline, and other necessary equipment/materials. Make sure all equipment is secured safely.
  - Check oil, fluids, tire pressure, proper trailer connection, and all lights are in working order.
2. Follow instruction from supervisor to accurately perform and manage tree care tasks on client's property including all aspects of tree removal, pruning, etc.
  - Work in conjunction with the Tree Care Supervisor to ensure that work contracted is implemented efficiently and according to contract specifics.
  - Provide labor associated with the maintenance of trees.
  - Perform all tasks of operations including but not limited to: climbing, pruning, inspecting, tree removal, etc.
  - Receive openly all trainings including safety, equipment use, technique, etc.
  - Follow the proper use of safety equipment & personal protective equipment.
  - Address any questions or concerns with clients professionally. Communicate the client's questions & concerns to the Tree Care Supervisor immediately.
3. Perform end of the day duties.
  - Accurately record hours worked on employee time sheet. Complete all job site reports and inventory all materials used on the job.
  - Review and prepare for the next day's job.
  - Unload/load equipment & material, clean out truck/trailer by removing trash, debris, etc.
  - Clean, maintain and repair all tools and equipment. Report any damaged or broken equipment to the Tree Care Supervisor.
4. Strictly adhere to Tree Trust's safety policies and procedures.
5. Assist LS Construction and Lawn Maintenance department, as needed.
5. Other duties as assigned.

### Skills/Requirements:

1. Must possess a strong work ethic, positive attitude and work well within a team.
2. Must be able to give work direction and work well under pressure within a fast paced, deadline driven environment.
3. Must be teachable, trainable and project a proactive attitude-always looking for the next way to find solutions.
4. Must have strong communication skills and be an effective listener.

**Hours and Benefits:** This is a fulltime, day position but must be available for flexibility in the work schedule based on the project needs. Travel and overnight stays may be required on certain projects or during emergency response events.

**Qualifications:**

- Must be 18 years of age with a valid driver license and a clean driving record as determined by our insurance carrier.
- Must have or be able to obtain Class A CDL.
- Must have or be able to acquire chemical applicator license with endorsements A, E and J within 90 days.
- 2 years of experience applying chemicals
- Must be able to pass a criminal background and motor vehicle check.
- Must have the ability to frequently climb, bend, stoop, twist and frequently lift 50 pounds.
- 2 years of experience operating power equipment including chain saws, skid steers, wood chippers, stump grinders
- Must be reliable, possess a positive attitude and be able to work independently.

Must enjoy working outdoors and be willing to work in a variety of weather conditions.
